

Good afternoon,

I have been in contact with the NHTSA several times regarding a Land Rover recall. My client owned a Land Rover that caught fire in December of 2021. When he informed the manufacturer of this event, they informed him that his vehicle was under recall. However, he never received notification from the manufacturer that his vehicle was under recall. Right after this happened, in January 2021, he looked on the NHTSA website and his vehicle's VIN was not associated with the recall. A few months later, his vehicle is now listed with that recall, with a reporting date of August 2021 (months before the fire had happened).

I was referred to this email by the NHTSA, because we are trying to figure out how this VIN was associated with the recall after the initial reporting period. Is someone able to tell me if his VIN number was within the range of VIN numbers originally reported to the NHTSA?
