RE: Safety complaint

To Whom It May Concern:

I own a 2018 Chevy Cruze sedan. Recently, I replaced the headlight bulbs with LED bulbs. When attempting to properly aim the headlights for safe light distribution, I discovered that the projector headlights in my car do not have a horizontal aim adjustment. There is a screw that can adjust the vertical plane of the headlights using a Phillips screwdriver, but no adjustment for horizontal aim.

The light distribution of my new headlamp bulbs is uneven, not aimed correctly, and there is apparently no way to fix this.

I know that vehicle lighting is an important safety factor. Recently I read about a recall of approximately 727,000 GMC Terrain vehicles (model years 2010-2017) due to headlight glare into oncoming traffic. Since NHTSA takes this complaint seriously, I think you should look into the number of Chevy Cruze vehicles sold where headlights cannot be properly adjusted.
