I am concerned about the fact that the shock tower housing on the 20 is retaining water and the bolts are rusting from this- if this let's go while driving myself and any occupants could be seriously injured or killed. I have also been told by a friend who is an engineer that if this gets destroyed the car is junk because it cannot be replaced due to the way the structure of the car is made.

I am also concerned about rocks destroying or damaging the radiator due to the lack of a protective screen even though this is not a safety concern.

I would like General Motor to supply a minimum of a ten year warranty on these parts or to rectify these problems before my new car warranty expires which is still in effect.
