VIN#1FMCU9G [REDACTED] we On the report. After the independent mechanic diagnosed an engine problem, it had been towed again to a FORD dealer. The FORD dealer ran tests and confirmed engine failure. The cost to repair \$10,000 +, was prohibitive without a recall, especially since there is a \$17,000 balance on the financed car only ten months earlier. Also, we were told it would take 4-6 months to get parts before the repair! Website information confirms the Ford vehicles from 2014-2019, with 1.5 economist engines exhibit problems that were encountered.
