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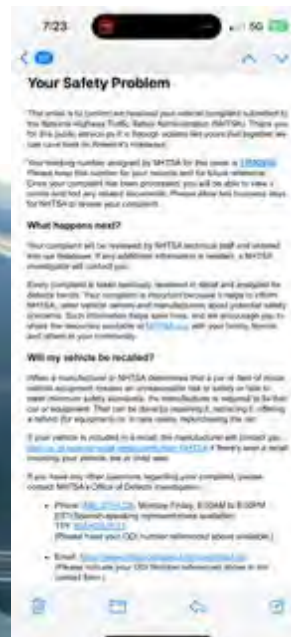

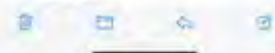
Will my vehicle be recalled?

If the manufacturer or NHTSA determines that a pair of tires of more limited equipment creates an unreasonable risk to safety or fails to meet minimum safety standards, the manufacturer is required to either recall or reequip. That can be done by repairing, retrofitting or offering a refund for equipment in more costly, replacing the set.

If your patient is included in a trial, the manufacturer will contact you. <http://www.fda.gov/oc/ohrt/implantation.htm> For ATTS, if there's been a trial involving your patient, we'll notify you.
