My BMW is subject to Recall Campaign No. 24V-104 (defective Integrated Brake Modules, published by NHTSB on February 12, 2024).

I had no notice of the recall when I purchased my BMW, new, in July, 2024,—at least four full months AFTER the commencement of the Recall Campaign.

I received BMW's recall letter in October, 2024.

To date, BMW has taken no action to remedy the defect.

How much longer should I have to drive an automobile with a known safety defect that, according to the recall, could result in a "loss of control" and "the risk of a crash"?

At this point I think it is reasonable to conclude that BMW has not remedied the defect within a reasonable period of time.

What we can we do to cause BMW to take appropriate action without waiting another year?

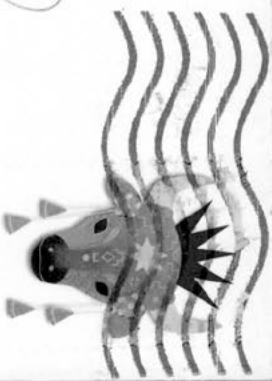
