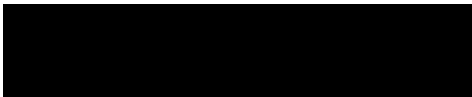

This is in reply to your recent letter to Chairman Homendy at the National Transportation Safety Board (NTSB) regarding your concerns with your 2023 Nissan Rogue and other Nissan products. She asked my office to reply to your letter.

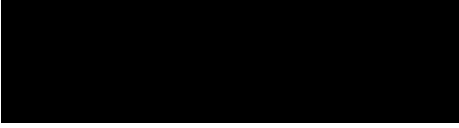
To provide you with some background, the NTSB is an independent federal agency charged by Congress with investigating every civil aviation accident in the United States and significant events in the other modes of transportation—railroad, transit, highway, marine, pipeline, and commercial space. We determine the probable causes of the accidents and events that we investigate, and issue safety recommendations aimed at preventing future occurrences. In addition, we conduct transportation safety research studies and offer information and other assistance to family members and survivors for each accident or event we investigate. We also serve as the appellate authority for enforcement actions involving aviation and mariner certificates issued by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and US Coast Guard, and we adjudicate appeals of civil penalty actions taken by the FAA. The NTSB derives its authority from Title 49 of the *United States Code*, Chapter 11. We do not regulate the motor vehicle or any other transportation industry, and we have no authority to enforce regulations.

The regulation of motor vehicle safety equipment, the investigation of potential vehicle defects, and the supervision of recalls are the responsibility of another federal agency, the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA).
