Subject: Urgent Safety Concerns Regarding Ford Bronco Sport – Battery and Stalling Issues

Dear NHTSA,

I am writing to formally report ongoing and serious safety concerns regarding my 2021 Ford Bronco Sport, which is currently under an active safety recall (NHTSA Recall 25V019). Despite this recall, I am experiencing critical issues that are putting my safety and that of other drivers at risk.

Since owning my vehicle, I have encountered persistent battery failures. My original battery died and had to be replaced, yet the new battery also failed despite testing as fully functional and brand new. Additionally, I have noticed that my vehicle stalls when making yielded turns, which is extremely concerning as it causes my vehicle to slow down unexpectedly in intersections where cross-traffic is present. This significantly increases my risk of an accident.

To make matters worse, just last night, on [REDACTED], my car failed to start after I made a stop at a gas station. This issue left me stranded and further reinforced my concerns about the reliability and safety of my vehicle. I fear that I am putting my life at risk by operating this vehicle in the condition that it is in currently.

Additionally, my check engine light is now on as a result of these issues, preventing me from renewing my vehicle registration. As an [REDACTED] I frequently drive through [REDACTED] where random vehicle inspections occur. If I am unable to renew my vehicle inspection due to this unresolved issue, it could affect my ability to perform my duties.

Given the severity of these problems and their potential to cause accidents or leave drivers in dangerous situations, I urge the NHTSA to investigate this matter further and work with Ford to expedite a solution.

I appreciate your time and consideration in addressing this urgent safety concern.
