Subject: Safety Complaint Regarding 2020 Nissan Leaf – VIN [REDACTED]

Dear NHTSA Safety Division,

I am writing to formally report a serious safety concern regarding my 2020 Nissan Leaf (VIN: [REDACTED]), which appears to be affected by a known defect involving the lithium-ion battery and DC fast charging capability.

Despite Nissan's acknowledgment of the issue and a recall campaign (R25A3), no effective remedy has been provided. Owners have been advised to avoid using Level 3 fast chargers due to the risk of battery overheating and fire. This restriction significantly compromises the vehicle's utility and safety, especially for long-distance travel.

I respectfully request that NHTSA investigate whether Nissan has met its obligations under federal safety regulations and whether further enforcement or expanded recall action is warranted. I am also seeking clarification on my rights as a consumer under current recall protocols.
