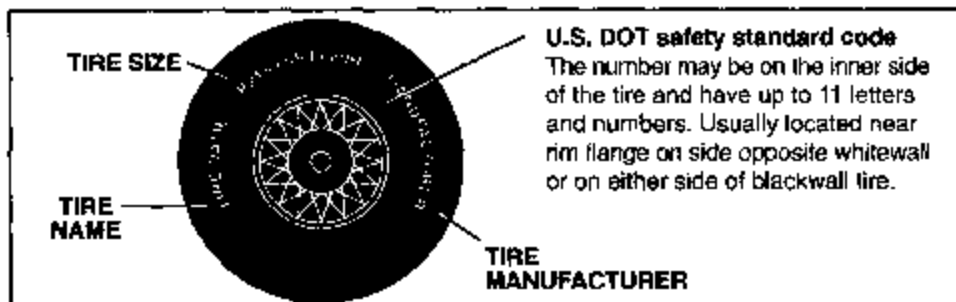

Automatic driver seat belt on door broke while driving. the wire just came out of the piece on the door (track) and seat belt. There was no accident or traction to the belt. This is a hazard. What would have happen if an accident occurred, there would not have been any security in the seat belt. I reported this to the dealer and they would not make the part good unless I paid \$795.00 for the part and about 350.00 for labor. The seatbelt was not abused and the wire came off the track and broke through no fault of a person. There was no warning of a faulty seat belt. ^{Automatic seat belt harness} Seatbelts should last the life of the car. Safety issue

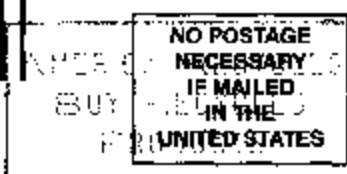
