This is hard to describe, so please also look at attached document (Right and left will be from point of view of occupants sitting in car.) For the center seat in rear - the belt goes from right hip over to left hip. The right seat-belt goes from right hip of to left hip. Problem - the female ^{receptacle} for the right seat is to the LEFT of the male connector coming out of the center seat. Hence, if three people get in back seat, and buckle-up, and say, the last to get in is the person in right seat, this person cannot get his buckle into his female receptacle because the strap for the center seat

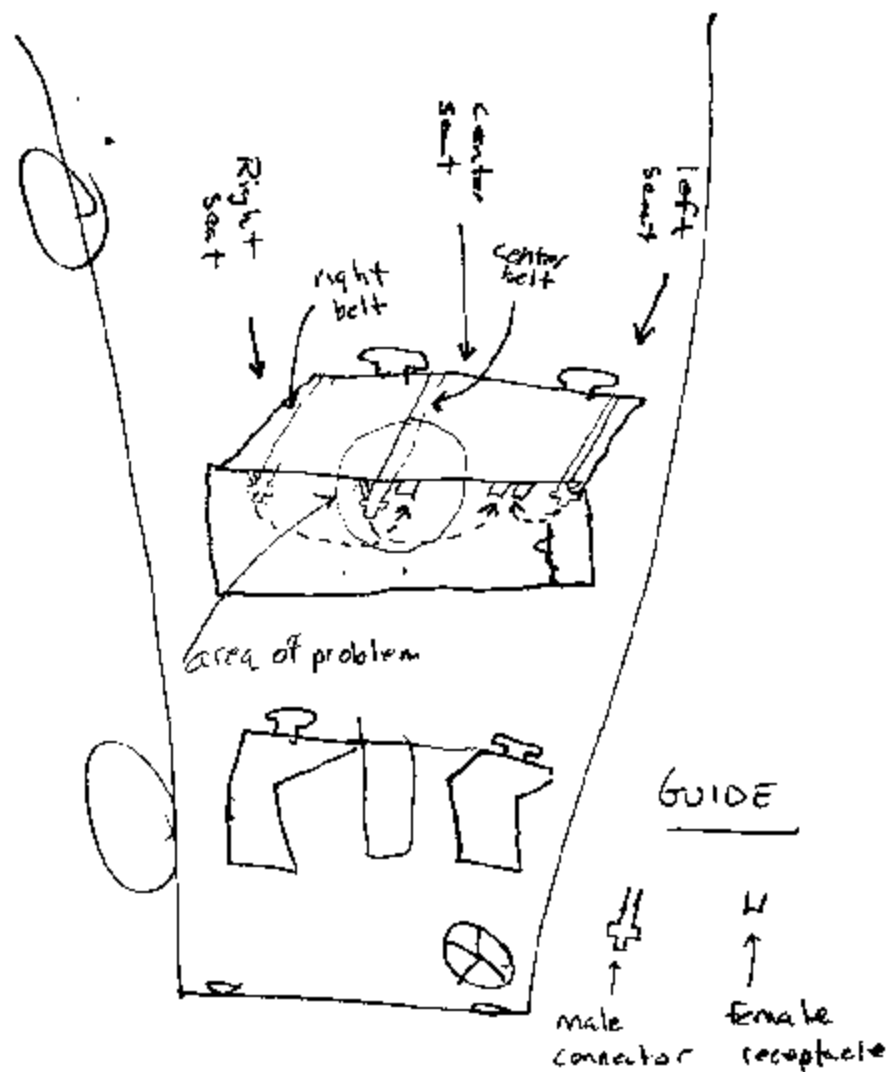
