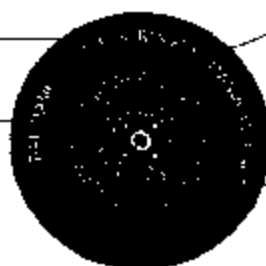

I don't remember what the mileage was the first time the odometer stopped working. It lasted about 3 or 4 days and just started working again when I hit 69,000 miles, however, I noticed that there were dig marks on the 6 and on the 9. I suspect tampering but don't know what to do or even where or who to start with. When I hit 69,999 the odometer would not roll. I took it to a garage to show them the dig marks. They said it definitely looked like someone had rolled it back. I went on the internet to CARFAX.COM to do a search of this vehicle. I have enclosed a copy of that. Since I have owned this vehicle, I have had to do many repairs which should not have to be done ~~the~~ to a vehicle this age with the miles shown - i.e. replace transmission, replace left front tie rod end, steering rack (needed but not repaired as of yet), sway bar link, shocks + struts, and more.

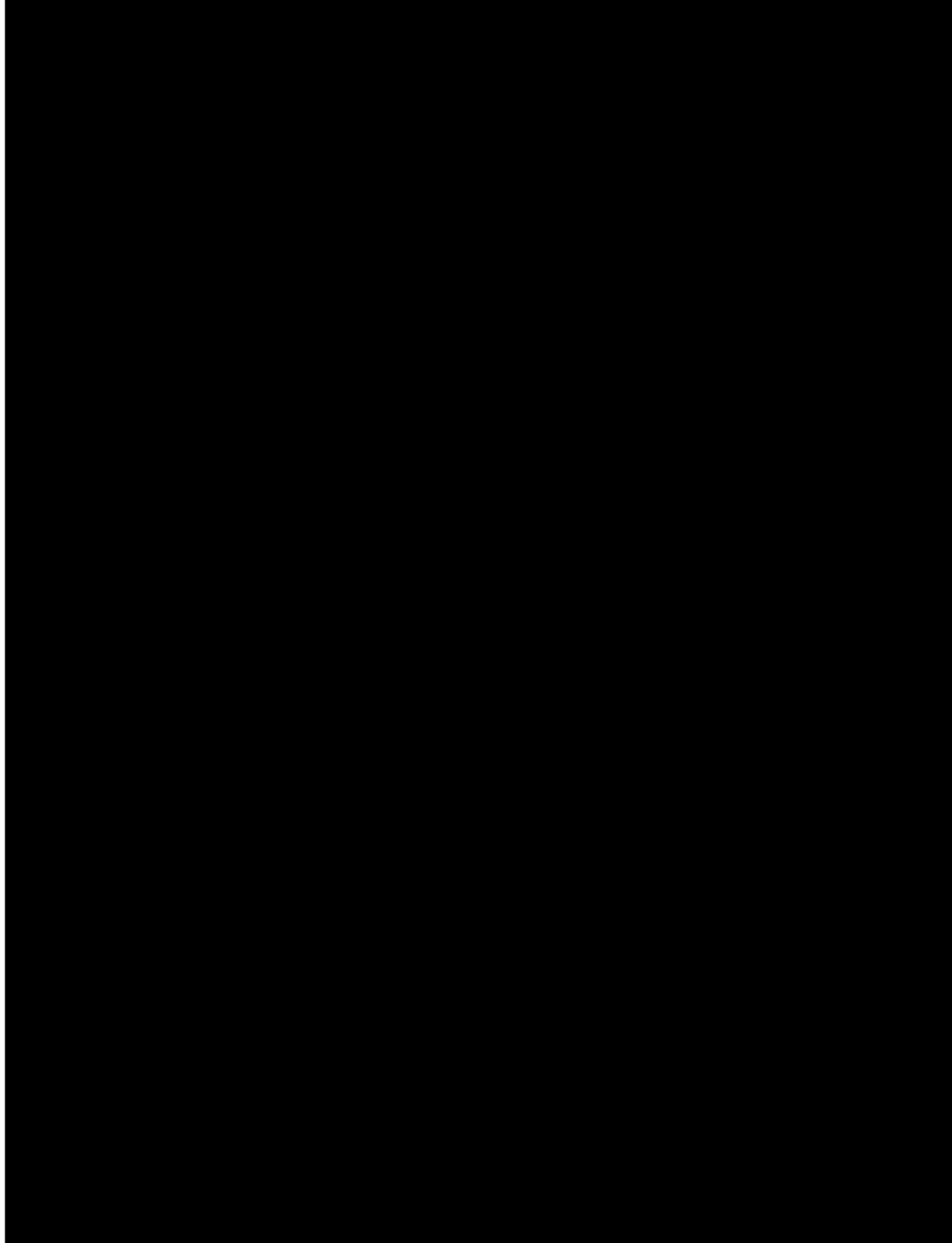

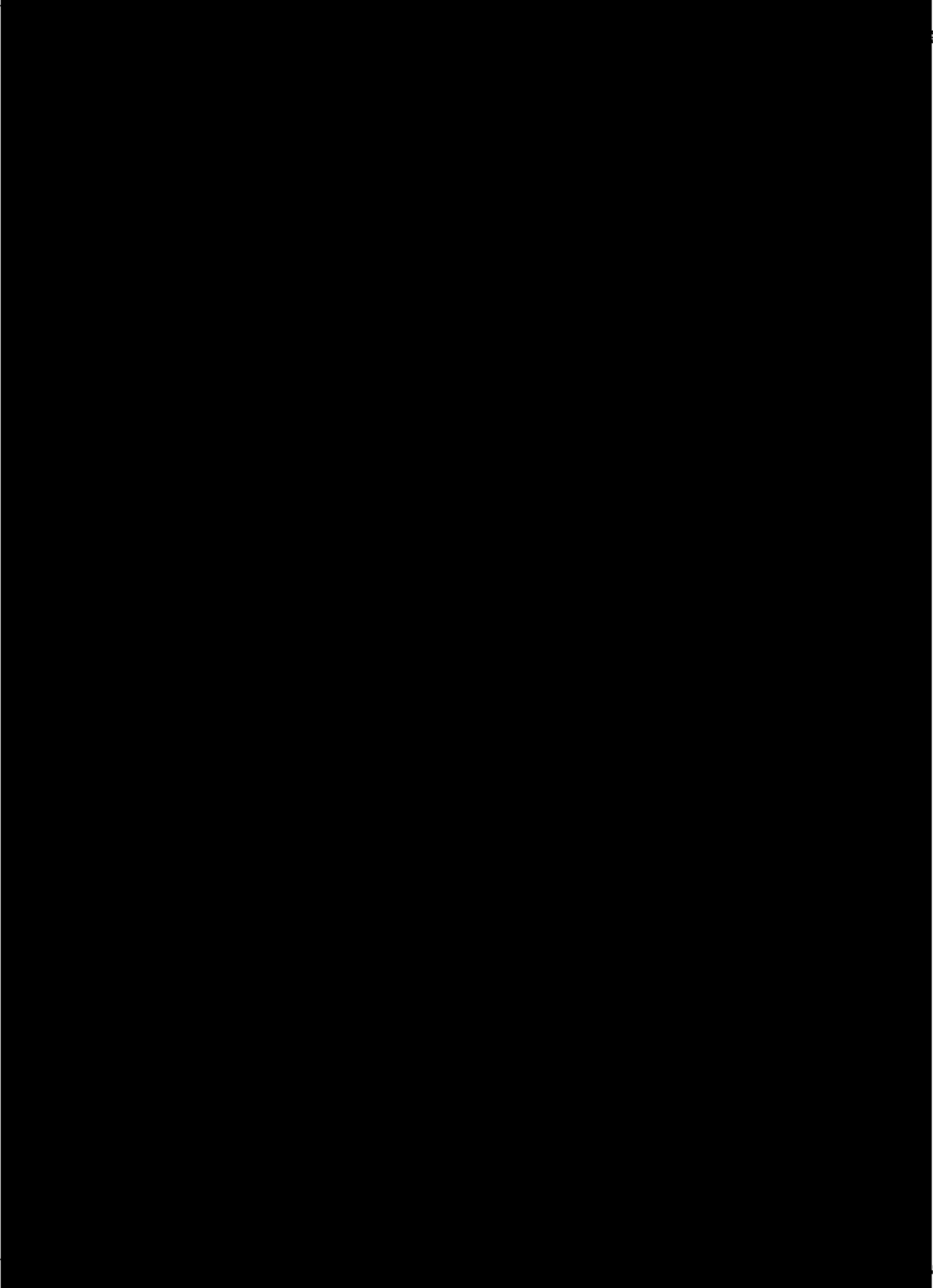

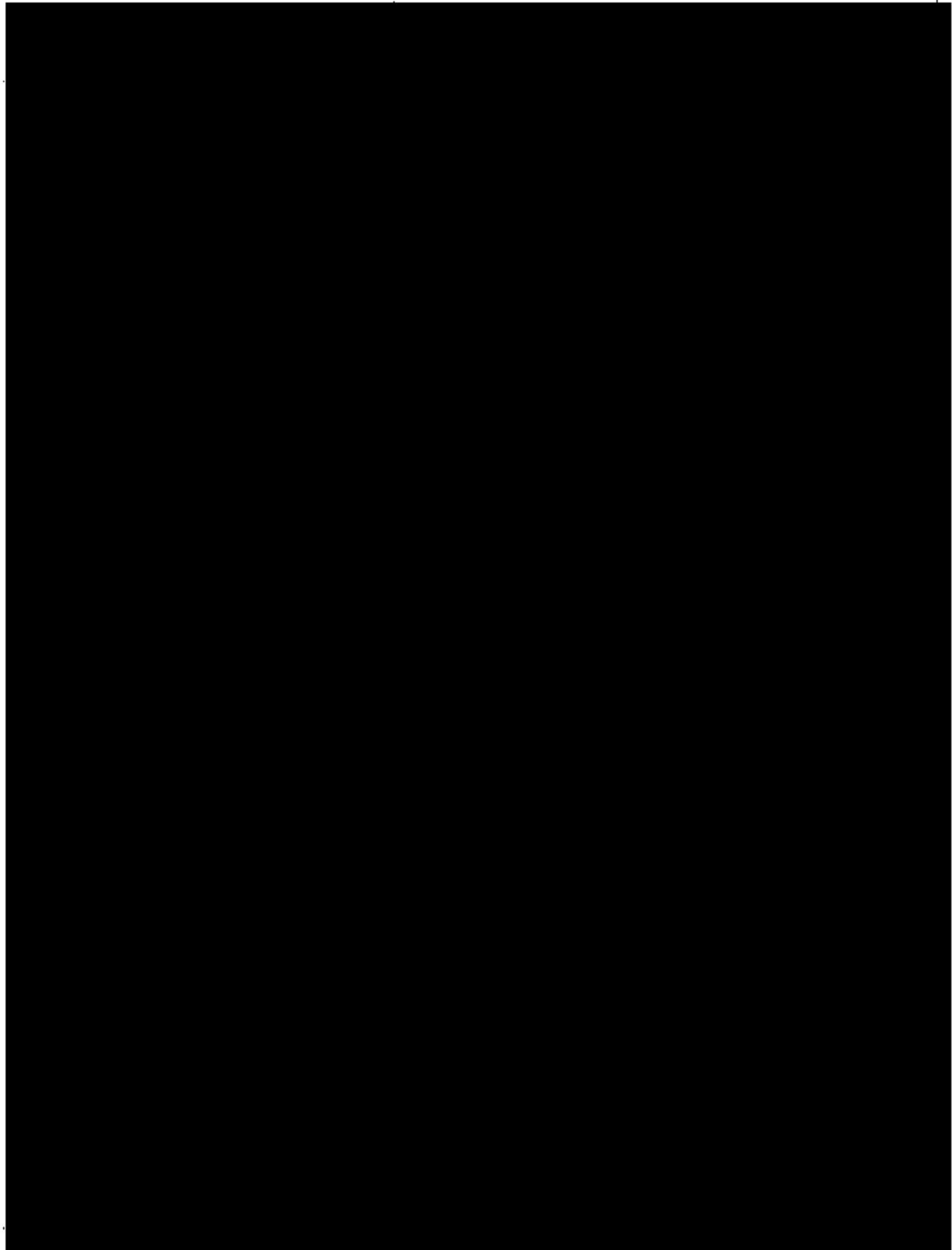
