TIRE PLACARD ON DOOR STATES WRONG TIRE SIZE (P215/75/R15) WITH TIRE PRESSURE OF 33 LBS. NOTHING IN THE 2001 OWNERS MANUAL GIVES THE CORRECT INFORMATION ON TIRE AIR PRESSURE. HAVE CALLED CHRYSLER WITH NO HELP THEY SAID TO CALL GOODYEAR. GOODYEAR SAYS CALL CHRYSLER 11/14/01 CALLED CHRYSLER AGAIN TOLD THEM WHAT I HAD FOUND FROM GOODYEAR SAID THEY ONLY PUT MINIMUM TIRE SIZE ON DOOR. MY EXPERIENCE TELLS ME THOSE LARGE TIRES WOULD NOT TAKE THE SAME AIR PRESSURE AS THE OTHER 3 SIZES OFFERED ON THIS VEHICLE. WENT TO DEALER TO HAVE THEM CHECK THEY SAID TIRE PRESSURE IS ON TIRE PLACARD
