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**NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION OF FAILURE(S), INCIDENT(S), INJURY(IES)**

WHILE TRAVELING AT 70MPH WITH 2 PASSENGERS IN CAR ON A RAINING EVENING, THE TRANSMISSION HAD A CATASTROPHIC FAILURE THAT LOCKED IT INTO "LIMP MODE". THE TRANSMISSION DOWNSHIFTED FROM OVERDRIVE TO 2ND GEAR AT 70 MPH ON A WET HIGHWAY. LUCKILY NO ACCIDENT RESULTED IN THIS CASE. CHRYSLER WAS CONTACTED AND TOLD US THEY WILL DO NOTHING BECAUSE IT WAS PAST THEIR WARRANTY. WE HAD A SECOND TRANSMISSION INSTALLED IN THE CAR, IT FAILED AFTER 15300 MILES. THIS FAILURE ALSO OCCURED ON THE HIGHWAY, LUCKILY AT A MUCH LOWER RATE OF SPEED WHILE ON THE ON RAMP. WE HAVE TALKED TO OTHER PEOPLE WHO HAVE HAD THEIR TRANSMISSION FAIL ON THEM ON THE SAME PLATFORM OF CAR AND ALSO, YOUR (NHTSA) DATABASE SHOWS NUMEROUS PROBLEMS/FAILURES WITH THE SAME E
