FRONT BRAKES SHAKE VIOLENTLY WHEN APPLIED AT SPEED BETWEEN 40 AND 60 MPH. CONTINUE SHAKING UNTIL VEHICLE IS BELOW 40 MPH OR DRIVER LETS UP ON BRAKES. I'VE READ THROUGH THE COMPLAINTS AND SEE THE SAME THING OVER AND OVER. I FIRST HAD THE PROBLEM AT 3,707 MILES (1/29/99) AND ARCHER JEEP IN HOUSTON RESURFACED THE FRONT ROTORS. IT HAPPENED AGAIN AT 10,427 MILES (6/17/99) AND THEY AGAIN RESURFACED FRONT ROTORS. WHEN IT HAPPENED THE THIRD TIME 16,750 MILES (11/11/99) THEY REPLACED THE FRONT ROTORS. NOW, AT 26,090 MILES (5/17/00) THE PROBLEM HAD RETURNED AGAIN. THIS IS OBVIOUSLY NOT A ROTOR PROBLEM AND IF IT HAPPENS ON A WET ROAD, AN ACCIDENT WILL MOST CERTAINLY RESULT. THIS IS NOT A MAINTENANCE OR DEALER PROBLEM. THE DEALER HAS BEEN MOST HELPFUL. JEEP/CHRYSLER SHOU
