WHILE DRIVING THIS CAR ON CITY STREETS, I SUFFERED A SUDDEN LOSS OF MY POWER STEERING WHICH MADE CONTROL OF MY CAR DIFFICULT. I WAS ADVISED BY A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE DEALER THAT THIS IS A KNOWN DESIGN FLAW IN THIS VEHICLE WHERE ONE OF THE PRESSURE FITTINGS CAN FAIL. AS A HEALTHY MALE, DRIVING ON CITY STREETS AT RELATIVELY SLOW SPEEDS, THERE WAS NO LOSS OF CONTROL OF THE CAR BUT STEERING, ESPECIALLY TURNING, BECAME EXTREMELY DIFFICULT. IT APPEARS THAT THIS "KNOWN DEFECT" IS NOT BEING AGGRESSIVELY ADDRESSED BY PONTIAC BUT WHETHER THEY ARE WAITING FOR SUCH FAILURES BEFORE REPLACING THE DEFECTIVE PARTS. I WOULD HATE TO THINK OF THE CONSEQUENCES, EVEN TO MYSELF, MUCH LESS A SMALLER PERSON, SHOULD SUCH A CATASTROPHE LOSS OF STEERING CONTROL OCCUR AT H
