FRONT END PULLS TO THE LEFT WHEN WHEN PASSING, FRONT IN SHAKES AT TIMES, DEALER REPLACED BRAKES, ABS SYSTEM, TIRES, WHEELS, DID ALINEMENTS AND TOLD US THAT IT IS NORMAL FOR THIS CAR TO PULL TO THE LEFT WHEN PASSING. WE TOLD THEM THAT WHEN THIS HAPPENS, WE FEEL THAT IT COULD CAUSE THE DRIVER TO LOSE CONTROL AND GO INTO ON COMING TRAFFIC. THEY SAID THEY HAVE DONE EVERYTHING POSSIBLE AND WE ARE STILL HAVING PROBLEMS WITH THE FRONT END. CURRENTLY THE BRAKES STARTED MAKING NOISE WHEN WE TURN THE CAR TO THE LEFT. THE DEALER SAYS WE WILL HAVE TO PAY FOR THIS PROBLEM SINCE OUR WARRENTY HAS EXPIRED. WE FEEL THAT THERE IS A MAJOR PROBLEM WITH THE DESIGN OF THE FRONT END SYSTEM INCLUDING THE ABS BRAKE SYSTEM, THE LOW TRACTION SYSTEM AND FR
