ALL SIX WERE REPLACED AND ONE OF THESE HAS ALREADY DEVELOPED THIS LUMP. I HAVE ALSO SEEN OTHER MOTORHOMES WITH THESE TIRES BLOW OUT AT HIGHWAY SPEEDS.
