ONCE THE AUTOMATIC SLIDING DOOR IS ACTIVATED IT CAN ONLY BE STOPPED BY A BUTTON, NO AMOUNT OF PRESSURE WILL STOP THE DOOR FROM CLOSING. THE MANUAL STATES THAT THE AMOUNT OF PRESSURE WILL HAVE TO INCREASE AS IT GETS CLOSER TO THE CLOSING POINT, BUT WE (SERVICE GUY) AND MYSELF COULD NOT STOP AFTER AN INCH OF MOVEMENT. HAVE TRIED THIS ON OTHER MONTANA'S WITH THE SAME RESULT. SINCE NO FORCE CAN STOP THIS DOOR, PEOPLE OR THINGS COULD GET CAUGHT. LOOKING FOR IT TO OPERATE LIKE AN ELEVATOR DOOR ESSENTIALLY. WHEN ENOUGH FORCE IS APPLIED THE DOOR STOPS OR REVERSES. THERE IS AN OVERRIDE IN THE CAR TO DISABLE THE AUTOMATIC DOOR, BUT THEN IT IS SO DIFICULT TO OPEN MANUALLY THAT IT IS NOT A DESIREABLE SITUATION. *AK
