THIS MALFUNCTION CAUSES THE AIR BAG SYSTEM TO SHUT DOWN, IT IS FREQUENT, KNOWN BY CHEVROLET, AND SEEMS TO BE DIFFICULT TO REPAIR SINCE AFTER 4 TIMES OF TAKING THE VEHICLE INTO SERVICE, THE PROBLEM HAS YET TO BE SOLVED. \*AK
