AT 8000 MILES, BRAKES WERE PULSATING BADLY. DEALER TURNED ROTORS "AS A COURTESY" WITHOUT ADDRESSING THE UNDERLYING PROBLEM. NOW, AT 19000 MILES, I AM HAVING TO REPLACE ALL FOUR BRAKES IN THEIR ENTIRETY; ROTORS, CALIPERS, PISTONS, ETC. LOCAL BRAKE SHOP SAYS CHRYSLER USES PLASTIC SLEEVES IN THEIR PISTONS INSTEAD OF METAL. THIS CAUSES OVERHEATING AND WARPING OF PISTON WHICH RESULTS IN WARPING OF ROTORS. THIS REPAIR WILL BE APPROXIMATELY \$1000.00. LOCAL BRAKE SHOP SAYS THIS IS A DESIGN FLAW ON CHRYSLER'S PART. WOULD APPRECIATE INVESTIGATION OF THIS PROBLEM. NOT ONLY IS IT EXPENSIVE, BUT MY BRAKES WERE SHOT....EMERGENCY STOPPING VERY MUCH IN QUESTION. THANK YOU. *AK
