ALL ENGINE STARTS REQUIRE AT LEAST 1 TO 2 MIN BEFORE ENGINE RPM'S COME DOWN TO 850 RPM. OTHERWISE THE VEHICLE JUMPS, NOT JERKS. VERY DANGEROUS SITUATION.*AK
