FRONT END NOISE WHEN APPLYING BRAKES. AT HIGH SPEEDS (50 MPH+) SERIOUS SHAKING AND VIBRATING OF THE FRONT END OCCURRED. RF CALIPER LOCKED ONTO WARPED ROTOR. PROBLEM WITH ROTORS WERE EXPERIENCED FROM DAY ONE. I'VE ENCOUNTERED OTHERS WHO HAVE HAD SIMILAR PROBLEMS WITH WARPED ROTORS ON THE MALIBU. EMERGENCY REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT OF CALIPERS, FRONT DISC BRAKES AND RIGHT FRONT ROTOR WAS DONE AT A NON-WARRANTY FACILITY AS THIS INCIDENT HAPPENED WHILE TRAVELLING AND THE LOCAL CHEVROLET DEALER SERVICE DEPT WAS NOT OPENED ON A SATURDAY.\*AK
