I HAD THE LEFT HEADLAMP COVER FALL OFF IN DECEMBER 2000, WHICH CAUSED THE HEADLIGHT TO BURN OUT. THE DEALER CLAIMED THAT WARRENTY WOULD NOT COVER, SO I HAD TO PAY \$110.00. IN JUNE, THE RIGHT COVER FELL OFF AND I REFUSED TO PAY. THE DEALER PAID FOR THE 2ND INCIDENT, SINCE I PAID FOR THE FIRST AND SPECIFICALLY REQUESTED THEM TO EXAMINE THE RIGHT COVER. IN MAY, THE BOTTOM MOLDING ON THE RIGHT SIDE, FRONT AND BACK DOORS CAME LOOSE, WHICH WOULD NOT ALLOW THE BACK DOOR TO OPEN. THE "GRAND PRIX GT" LETTERING ON THE LEFT SIDE ALSO FELL OFF. AFTER COMPLAINING TO THE DEALER, THEY FIXED THE GRAND PRIX LETTERING FOR FREE AND SPLIT THE COST OF THE DOOR MOLDING WITH ME. I FEEL THAT PONTIAC MUST BE USING A POOR ADHESIVE.*AK
