WHEN THE CAR INTERIOR IS HOT (I.E. DURING A SUNNY DAY) THE SIGNALS WILL WORK INTERMITTENTLY. AS THE A/C COOLS THE CAR, BETTER RESULTS ARE SEEN. WE KNOW OF ANOTHER '99 GRAND AM OWNER WHO SAYS THEY ALSO HAVE OCCASIONAL PROBLEMS WITH THEIR TURN SIGNALS. THE FOG LAMPS HAVE MYSTERIOUSLY TURNED THEMSELVES ON DURING THE NIGHT TWICE IN THE PAST YEAR. *AK
