SIDEWALL BUBBLES - TWO ON SAME TIRE 1/4 AROUND TIRE APART. I UNDERSTAND THAT A BUBBLE CAN BE CAUSE BY A POTHOLE IMPACT, HOWEVER, AFTER TALKING TO A NHTSA EXPERT AND VIEWING THE TIRE I AM NOT CONVINCED IT WAS NOT DEFECTIVE. THE TIRE IS A HIGH END TIRE (NOT CHEAP) AND SHOULD BE ABLE TO HOLD UP TO REGULAR DRIVING. SINCE THERE ARE TWO BUBBLES IT LENDS ITSELF TO THE VIEW THAT THERE WAS A DEFECT IN THE CORD ITSELF WHICH PERHAPS MADE IT WEAK. I AM CONCERNED AS MY CAR IS AN ALL WHEEL DRIVE VEHICLE AND I HAVE ALL FOUR MICHELIN PILOT ALPIN TIRES (SNOW TIRES) ON THE CAR. THE TIRES WERE PURCHASED IN NOV. 2000, AND WERE ONLY ON THE VEHICLE FOR THE WINTER. THEY HAVE APPROX. 3-4 K MILES ON THEM. I JUST HAD THEM PUT B.
