ON DECEMBER 14TH, MY '95 MUSTANG CAUGHT FIRE WHILE SITTING IN A PARKING LOT. ON DECEMBER 20TH THE DAMAGE WAS ASSESSED BY ERIC KROSSEN FROM SUMMITT CLAIM SERVICE (USED BY MY INSURANCE COMPANY) TO BE A TOTAL LOSS. FROM DEC 20-JAN 3, 2001, WE WERE NEGOTIATING WITH ANPAC FOR A FAIR SETTLEMENT BUT COULDN'T COME TO AN AGREEMENT. NEAR THE END THEY WERE NOT RETURNING OUR CALLS. ON JANUARY 3, 2001 WE RECEIVED A SAFETY RECALL #01S30 POST-MARKED DECEMBER 31, 2001 FROM FORD MOTOR COMPANY. THIS RECALL WAS FOR THE ENGINE COOLING FAN ON 95 TAURUS, SABLE AND MUSTANG VEHICLES. IT STATED THAT UNDER CERTAIN HIGH TEMPERATURE CONDITIONS, COMPONENTS INSIDE THE COOLING FAN MOTOR MAY IGNITE POTENTIALLY
