MY SUPPLEMENT RESTRAINT SYSTEM LIGHT CAME ON ABOUT 10 DAYS AGO CAUSED BY NO OBVIOUS REASON. I HAVE SINCE DISCOVERED AT THE SERVICE DEPT. THAT THEY DON'T KNOW EITHER WHY IT WENT OUT. I FEEL IT IS A SAFETY ISSUE AS I AM UNCLEAR HOW IT CAN EFFECT THE DEPLOYMENT OF THE AIRBAGS, COULD THEY GO AT ANY TIME OR PROBABLY NOT AT ALL WHEN NEEDED. I FOUND INFORMATION ON THE INTERNET RELATING TO THIS BUT UNFORTUNATLEY NOT MUCH AS FAR AS DETAILS. ON THE ALLDATA SITE THEY MADE REFERENCE TO TSB# 00-089 AND TWO FOR THE ACCORD (WHICH A DEALER TOLD ME IS VIRTUALLY THE SAME CAR) TSB # 96-061 AND 97-002. ALSO YOUR SITE MADE REFERENCE TO A SERV. BULLETIN # 000101 SEQUENCE # 103. SINCE MY CAR IS AT THE SHOP RIGHT
