THE PROBLEM WITH THIS CAR IS THAT THE POWER WINDOW REGULATORS HAVE FAILED IN EACH OF THE FOUR WINDOWS AT LEAST ONCE AND IN TWO OF THE WINDOWS A MINIMUM OF TWO TIMES EACH. WHEN THIS HAPPENS THE WINDOW FALLS INTO THE DOOR AND CANNOT BE EITHER RAISED OR LOWERED. IN EFFECT YOU WALK OUT TO YOUR CAR IN THE MORNING AND THE WINDOW IS DOWN. EACH OCCURRENCE COST \$550 TO REPAIR. APPARENTLY, ACCORDING TO THE DEALER SERVICE WRITER THIS IS A VERY COMMON PROBLEM ON GRAND PRIXS. THERE SHOULD BE A RECALL FOR THIS PROBLEM AS IT IS BOTH A SAFETY ISSUE AND UNFAIR EXPENSE ISSUE. I'LL BE HAPPY TO DISCUSS THIS WITH ANYBODY FROM NHTSA AS I HAVE COMPLETE DOCUMENTATION OF THE PROBLEM. *AK
