MY WIFE WAS INJURED WHEN THE SIDE AIRBAGS OF OUR 2002 ODYSSEY INADVERTENTLY DEPLOYED. AFTER SENDING THEIR REPRESENTATIVE AND AIRBAG EXPERTS TO EXAMINE OUR ODYSSEY, AMERICAN HONDA FAILED TO PROVIDE US AN EXPLANATION OF THE CAUSE AND THE FIX OF THIS DEFECT AS THEY PROMISED US 3 WEEKS AGO. THEY SIMPLY REPLACED SOME PARTS AND FORCED US TO RETURN THE RENTAL CAR AND TAKE BACK THE VAN. EVEN THE CLASSIC HONDA MANAGER ADMITTED TO ME THAT IF HONDA AGREES TO A TRADE IN, CLASSIC HONDA WOULD NOT ABLE TO RESELL OUR VAN DUE TO LIABILITY. YET THEY ARE ASKING US TO DRIVE OUR ODYSSEY AND RISK OUR LIVES AGAIN. BASED ON THE QUESTIONS HONDA ASKED DURING THEIR INVESTIGATION, AND THEIR REFUSAL TO ADDRESS THIS II
