Brakes squealing and had master cylinder replaced. Helped for a short time and they now squeal again. Vibration at 65 - 75 miles per hour. Dealer has not been able to fix. Doors shake and rattle. Afraid they will fall off. Brakes stop suddenly just about throwing passengers through windshield; if we weren't wearing seat belts, we would be injured. Dealer says its mud and dirt causing problem and can't seem to keep it repaired. Transmission was clunking when moving forward from stopped position and revved up to 5500-6000 rpm's for no reason while travelling at 65 mph. Dealer hasn't figured out the problem, yet. Vehicle has 37,000 miles.
