* The identification number consists of 7 to 10 letters and numerals following the letters DOT. It is usually located near the rim flange on the side opposite the whitewall or on either side of a blackwall tire.

NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION (CONTINUED)

A couple of years ago I received a recall notice from Honda about my airbags. Rushneck Honda checked and said my car was not involved in the recall.

In Jan of 2002 my SRS light came on. Dealer checked it and said the SRS Electronic Control Unit failed and had to be replaced. Honda said my car was not involved in recall.

Please see your notice and my bill - billing me for the part that was recalled.

The recall involved 4 cylinder Hondas - Only about 5% of Hondas are V6's - My car is a V6 and probably not enough units are known about & failures are not as visible. I believe Honda should reimburse me for this expense and that the V6 Hondas should be recalled.
