ABS System as far as I'm concern, doesn't work at all. Front Brakes when applied will lock, rear wheels don't work at all they just roll along. Because when operating brakes, I have moved mirrors that I can see rear wheels. The back brakes don't seem to be operating at all. I have put on 2 sets of brake pads on front. Have pulled rear wheels off and checked brake pads and they look hardly worn at all these are the original brake pads. I believe I'm doing with on 2 wheel brake as results almost total collision. Most of time the truck is drive empty. The most weight we have in truck is 700 to 800 lbs. We also had a 1993 Ford F150 that had same problem.
