DUE TO GAS TANK RUSTING VEHICLE STARTED LEAKING FUEL. HAD GAS TANK REPLACED BY MECHANIC *AK ON 3 JULY, 2001 AT A COST OF \$460.38. THE TWO OTHER ATTEMPTS TO FIX RUST LEAKS ON 14 JUN 2001 AND 16 MAY 2001 USING "JB WELD" FAILED (AT A COST OF \$80.00). RUSTING HAD BEEN OCCURRING FOR SOME TIME PRIOR TO FIRST LEAK REPAIR. GAS TANKS SHOULD LAST 20-25 YEARS MINIMUM.
