However, the spare is a 16 wheel & tire. The four tires are Goodyear & Spare is Firestone. The Owners Manual says that you can lose control of vehicle if you use different size tires. This is an unsafe configuration and the manufacturer should be required to put 5 wheels & tires that are all same size.
