Severe Engine noise rattle sluggish problem creates poor gas milage. Engine creates very poor excitation when cold and in cold weather. I have been told on several occasions by GM dealer mechanics and GM employee that General Motors knows there is a problem but they do not want to pay to correct the problem or fix the problem that exist for the vehicle owner. Had I been told there was a problem with the pistons or (piston slap) in this engine I would not have ordered it in my new vehicle. Now General Motors says the problem will cause no long term damage. I just want my vehicle to run properly or they can replace the vehicle with one that does. You can not tell me that an engine that does not work properly will have the same life expectancy as one that does run properly. The Truck runs like a junker and sounds like it too. I guess you should not expect much for \$44,000.00!!
