in a crash the Adult passenger would sustain serious abdominal chest injuries since the male/female seat belt unit moves up toward the chest & does not stay at hip level.

also a child car seat will not stay in place for same reason - The movement of the seat belt is due to both the shoulder/lap belt being non-ratcheting as well as the female unit not being fit in position.

Please see into a solution for my problem since I need to use those seats to transport my children. Thank you.

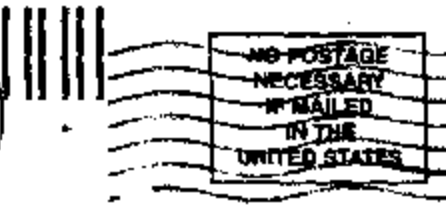

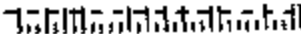

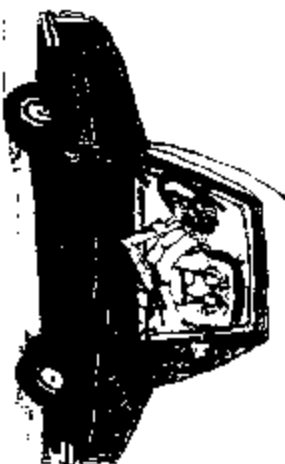
