NARRATIVE BY: CAPT. MUNSON

ARRIVED AND FOUND BROWARD CCUNY ENGINE 32 ON SCENE. FIRE HAD BEEN A VW CAMPER/VAN. FIRE HAD BEEN ALMOST EXTINGUISHED BY " PEP BOY " EMPLOYEES WHEN ENGINE 32 ARRIVED. THE TWO MEN ARE ED PEREZ AND JASON DIPOFI. BOTH SUFFERED INHALATION OF SMOKE AND DRY CHEM. FROM EXTINGUISHERS THEY USED TO PUT OUT FIRE. BOTH WERE TREATED AND TRANSPORTED TO MEMORIAL BY HOLLYWOOD RESCUES 74 AND 31. ENGINE 74 TOOK CARE OF OVERHAUL AND NOTIFIED THE BFP. INSPECTOR SEXSMITH RESPONDED AND INVESTIGATED INCIDENT.
