SYNOPSIS OF ACCIDENT:

ON THE NIGHT OF FEBRUARY 2, 2001 - AT APPROXIMATELY - 9:30 PM. I PARKED MY TRUCK IN A WELL LIT, ASPHALT, LEVEL PLANED, PARKING LOT. BEING OF SOBER MIND AND JUDGEMENT. I, PRESSED DOWN THE BRAKE PEDAL, THE VEHICLE CAME TO A COMPLETE STOP, AND I PLACED THE VEHICLE'S GEAR SHIFT FIRMLY INTO "P" PARK.

WITH THE VEHICLE STILL IDLING, AND MY WIFE SEAT BELTED INTO THE FRONT PASSENGER SEAT. I REMOVED MY FOOT FROM THE BRAKE PEDAL, RELEASED MY SEATBELT, TURNED AND RECIEVED GROCERY MONEY FROM MY WIFE. I THEN OPENED MY DOOR AND EXITED THE TRUCK.

MY WIFE REMAINED IN THE VEHICLE WITH THE ENGINE IDLING AND HEATER ON. AFTER WALKING AWAY FROM THE TRUCK, I HAD WALKED 50 FT. WHEN I HEARD A LOUD ENGINE REV. DIRECTLY BEHIND ME. I TURNED JUST IN TIME TO JUMP OUT OF THE WAY OF MY TRUCK WHICH WAS TRAVELING AT A HIGH RATE OF SPEED BACKWARDS TOWARD THE STORE FRONT WINDOWS. THE VEHICLE CONTINUED BY ME AND SMASHED THROUGH THE STORE FRONT WINDOWS OF (A+K LIQUOR) COMING TO REST IN THE REAR RIGHT SIDE OF SHOP.

I WENT TO MY WIFE'S AID. WHEN I ARRIVED THE VEHICLE WAS IN A HIGH REV. AND MY WIFE WAS IN A TWISTED POSITION BETWEEN THE CONSOLE AND THE DRIVER'S SEAT. SHE WAS COVERED IN GLASS AND

WAS PHYSICALLY SHAKEN. IN AN EFFORT TO PREVENT A FIRE; I ASKED HER TO PUT THE GEAR SELECTOR IN PARK, SHE STATED IT WAS IN PARK. I REACHED ACROSS THE PASSENGER SEAT AND CENTER CONSOLE, TURNED THE IGNITION OFF AND REMOVED THE KEYS. I NEVER HAD TO TOUCH THE GEAR SELECTOR THE WHOLE TIME IN DOING THIS, AND NEITHER DID MY WIFE.

THE PASSENGER (WIFE) "AUDREY NICHOLS" SAID THAT ABOUT 20 SECONDS AFTER I EXITED THE TRUCK, CLOSED MY DOOR, AND WALKED AWAY. SHE HEARD A CREAKING SOUND AND THEN THE TRUCK LURCHED BACKWARDS PICKING UP SPEED VERY QUICKLY. SHE RELEASED HER SEATBELT IN AN EFFORT TO SOMEHOW GAIN CONTROL (STOP) THE TRUCK. SHE WAS ATTEMPTING TO GET A LEG BY THE CENTER CONSOLE WHEN THE VEHICLE COLLIDED WITH PARKING LOT CURBING WHICH CAUSED HER TO BE THROWN AROUND THE FRONT OF CAB WILDLY. THE TRUCK SPED UP HIT THE STORE FRONT SIDEWALK. THIS AGAIN THREW HER BACK AND FORTH WILDLY. THE VEHICLE JUMPED THROUGH THE STORE FRONT SMASHED THROUGH AISLES OF LIQUOR AND SOFT DRINKS EVENTUALLY COMING TO A STOP AGAINST SIDE REAR WALL OF SHOP. THERE WERE "FORTUNATELY" NO INJURIES TO ANYONE INVOLVED WITH THE INCIDENT

DRIVER HAS DRIVEN DODGE-RAM TRUCKS FOR PAST 8 YEARS CONTINUOUSLY (EXPERIENCED WITH PERFORMANCE) DRIVER HAS NO CITATIONS ISSUED PREVIOUS TO ACCIDENT, 20-20 VISION, NORMAL HEARING, AND NO PHYSICAL LIMITATIONS.

- 1) VEHICLE HAS NEVER BEEN PUT UNDER SEVERE USAGE.
- 2) PRIOR TO ACCIDENT, THE VEHICLE HAD NO VISIBLE DEFECTS. (SAFE OPERATION)
- 3) THE TRUCK JUST HAD A THOROUGH EVALUATION BY DEALERS MECHANIC.
- 4) NO WARNING INDICATOR LIGHTS OR ALARMS HAVE EVER SHOWN ON VEHICLE DISPLAY. (EXCEPTIONS WERE "LOW FUEL" + "SEAT BELT".)

Driver charged with DUI

No one was injured Friday night when this pickup crashed through the front window of the AK Discount Liquor store on North Nova Road. Holly Hill police said the driver Bradley Nichols, 39, of Holly Hill, thought he had put the vehicle in park when he got out to walk to the liquor store about 9:20 p.m. Officers said he apparently left it in reverse. His wife, Audrey Nichols, was sitting in the passenger seat and leaned across the center console to try to hit the brake, but ~~mistakenly~~ pushed the accelerator pedal and sent the truck careening through the storefront. Store owner Anton Karborani said one customer was inside when the accident happened. "I thought it (the sound of breaking glass) was machine-gun fire," Karborani said. "I dove to the far side of the counter and ducked until I realized what had happened." Police arrested Nichols and charged him with driving under the influence. Additional charges are pending.
