Contacted the vehicle manufacturer of failure, they sent and adjuster to examine the vehicle, and said that the airbag system was operating properly, and that it did not have to deploy in a frontal collision at 55 m.p.h. That's a REAL good safety feature, that probably cost me a lot of money for nothing.
