3 of 4 of retainers rusted completely away. Only retainer intact was upper front left. Upper front right, lower front and lower back left gone. Most of cradle fell to ground. Losing steering ability. I was traveling at a speed of only 10-15 mph in a quiet neighborhood without any other traffic. I was lucky. I just got off I-75 traveling at a speed of 70 mph (over).
