My computer is that the ECM out - computer will not function properly now that the LED fell inside the computer. I now have and opened where the LED was - keptel and queues messal refused to even look at the computer - they say '95's don't have LED's - my car was made in 3/95. Perhaps they carried over LED's into the early '95's. I called Nissan corp 800-647-7261 to have an "expert" call me and state whether any stored wiring on the LED connectors will fault the computer. I got a message (2nd hand) on my ans - wiring machine that my car has no LED - I have a recording on tape of that message as proof.

The 1st time I had to use the ECM I got the codes off the LED - from O2 sensor. The 2nd time I noticed the LED missing - I did not touch the LED. I then brought the car in and found that the codes appear on the check engine light on the dash board also. P.S. I'm not looking for a computer replacement if I know that a blown wire or some other connection might happen to the LED will not fault the ECM out. I'm not asking for work.
