RECALL 93V125000 REPAIRS WERE DONE, BUT DEFECT REOCCURRED. *AK on 4/5/01 Balisc checked and confirmed that check valves had been installed on fuel lines. Ever since then the "check engine" display light in the dash has lit up. Balisc told me that indicates an emission problem - just a coincidence - nothing they caused while checking fuel lines. Balisc said they would look at it again but I would have to pay a diagnostic fee of \$75.00. I am the original owner. This light has never come on before - The pass book indicates that this warning light indicates a fuel transfer problem. Balisc should have followed up on this problem. AT NO COST.
