THE OWNER HAD CONCERNS ABOUT THE RETAINER CLIPS ON THE BUILT IN CHILD SAFETY SEATS. THEY EASILY PULLED APART WHEN PRESSURE WAS APPLIED. DEALERSHIP ADVISED THIS WAS THE DESIGN. THIS DESIGN WOULD INJURY A SMALL CHILD BY LETTING THE STRAPS COME APART.
