While traveling eastbound Hwy 98, Aug. 18, 2001 at 4pm at 55 mph, I heard an explosion. The front wheels then locked up and for 2-3 seconds I had no control off the car. The front wheels then freed & began to turn enough to get us off the highway. There were no cars around us.
