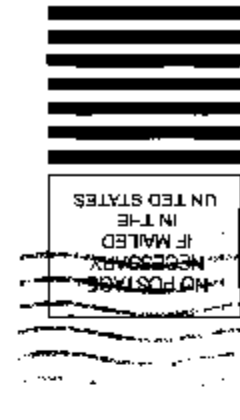
WHILE DRIVING IN THE

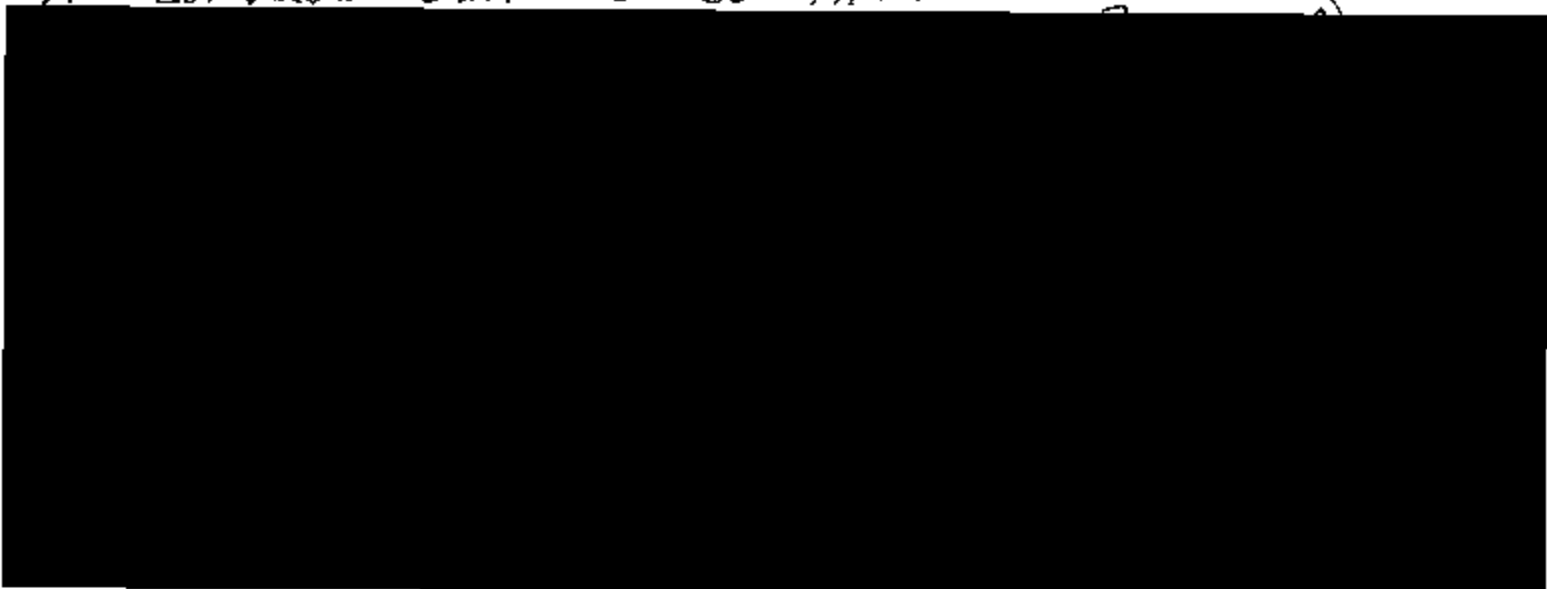
