IF THE MOTORCYCLE IS EXPOSED TO WATER, SUCH AS BEING WASHED OR RIDDEN IN THE RAIN, THE THROTTLE CABLE HOUSINGS REMAIN WETTER BECAUSE THE THROTTLE CABLES ARE TOWED IN A "U" SHAPE. IF THE MOTORCYCLE IS THEN EXPOSED TO AMBIENT TEMPERATURES OR WIND CAUSING IT OR BELOW FREEZING, THEN THE WATER TRAPPED INSIDE THE THROTTLE CABLES FREEZES, AND REBANDS THE THROTTLE COMPLETELY INOPERABLE.

THE MOTOR IS NO LONGER ABLE TO CONTROL ENGINE SPEED AND MUST RESORT TO USING THE ENGINE KILL SWITCH BEFORE FULLY OFF THE ROAD. THIS HAS HAPPENED TO ME NUMEROUS TIMES AT HIGHWAY SPEEDS IN WET TRAFFIC. MY MOTORCYCLE IS SCHEDULED FOR A DEALER VISIT FOR THE SECOND TIME IN ONE YEAR OF OWNERSHIP REGARDING THIS. DUCATI NORTH AMERICA HAS BEEN CONTACTED AND DOES NOT AGREE THAT A SAFETY ISSUE EXISTS. 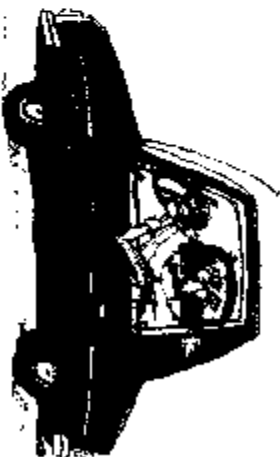
