

2019 CRSS Release Notes

12/18/2020: 2019 CRSS files are released. This is the first 2019 CRSS file release.

- Starting from 2019, the CSV files will include both ID and TEXT for look-up fields.
- NHTSA discontinued releasing **VINDECODE** file starting from 2018 CRSS file release.
- Both 32-bit and 64-bit format files are released.
- A new file **NMDISTRACT** is added (Please see CRSS Analytical User's Manual for details).

3/2/2022: The followings have been updated for 2019 CRSS files:

- Publish VPICDECODE and VPICTRAILERDECODE files. These files are created using NHTSA's vPIC tool and contains the vPIC decode results for cleanly decoded VINs.
