I have attached a copy of letters assigning our WMI code originally to our parent company and more recently to Pinnacle Industrial Services. I confirmed this number as currently valid with the Society of Automotive Engineers.

Please note the slight difference in the Vehicle Description Positions. These units have been produced for a number of years with a VIN description established using the format for these positions per the attached copy of Table 1 from the Transport Canada manual. I trust this will be satisfactory as it represents a unique description of the vehicle.

Also included is a Check Digit Calculation worksheet using our next available Sequential Production Number. As well a copy of our proposed Identification Plate. This is printed on a metallic material secured with adhesive that does not allow the plate to be transferred. The required lettering to complete to the boxes is embossed with a typing machine. This would be installed on the forward corner of the left side of the trailer.
