

Condition Description

Left front all weather floor mat interferes with the proper operation of the accelerator pedal when the mat is not properly installed.

Diagnostic Steps:

- 1. Road test vehicle and verified the interference between the accelerator pedal and the all weather floor mat.
- 2. Next removed the all weather floor mat and road tested the vehicle and found that the operation of the accelerator pedal was normal.

Probable Cause

Improper installation of all- weather floor mat.

Cut flashing off of the rear portion of the mat and reinstalled into the vehicle with the retainer clips installed and the interference with the accelerator pedal was no longer evident.




Photo showing location of the accelerator pedal interference with floor mat.
